

Who is eligible for Early Head Start in Cambria County?

If family's income level falls within the federal poverty guidelines then the family is eligible for Early Head Start. Please see 2011 Income Guidelines chart below.

If the enrolling child or any member of his/her immediate family receives SSI (Social Security Income) the family is automatically eligible for Early Head Start.

If the enrolling family receives TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, often called "cash assistance") the family is automatically eligible for Early Head Start.

Foster children and homeless families are automatically eligible for Early Head Start.
